To the Minister of Health and Social Services

On 20 May 2015, in reply to a question asked by the Official Opposition concerning the day centre tariff increase – of more than 600 % for paratransit and of 87 % for meals –, the Minister of Health made the following statement:

"Given that this flyer was sent out without my knowledge, I asked that the application of the said flyer be suspended to restore the previous situation so that we can assess the situation."

- Can the Minister table the directive he issued, in which he demanded that the application of the flyer sent to day centres without his knowledge on 3 October 2014 be suspended?
- On which date was this directive issued?
- Can he confirm that as of today (10 June 2015), the tariffs that applied before the flyer's publication have been reinstated?
- What is the current status? When does he intend to make it known?

To the Minister of Health and Social Services

A meningococcal serogroup B vaccination campaign targeting individuals age 2 months to 20 years was carried out in 2014 in the Saguenay–Lac-Saint-Jean region. The purpose of this intervention was to control the high prevalence of invasive meningococcal serogroup B infections in this region.

- How many cases of meningococcal serogroup B infections were registered in the past five years? In which regions were they registered?
- What is the Minister of Health and Social Services' assessment of the 2014 vaccination campaign against invasive infections caused by meningococcal serogroup B carried out in the Saguenay–Lac-Saint-Jean region?
- What is the opinion of the Québec Immunization Committee regarding the use of this vaccine in other regions or even throughout Québec?
- What are the Minister's intentions in that regard?
