At 10.52 o'clock a.m., Mr. Gendron, Third Vice-President, rendered his decision on the receivability of the amendment.

RULING FROM THE CHAIR

The amendment is receivable, since nothing prevents the Assembly from reexamining at the report stage any decision taken by the committee during clause-byclause consideration. A committee is an organ of the Assembly to which the latter has made an order to examine a bill. When a committee's report is taken into consideration, the Assembly is informed of the work carried out in committee, but its power to amend a bill is not restricted by that exercised in committee.
