Motions Without Notice

Mrs. Poirier (Hochelaga-Maisonneuve), together with Mr. Khadir (Mercier), moved a motion concerning the sale of armoured vehicles to Saudi Arabia; this motion could not be debated for want of unanimous consent.

By leave of the Assembly to set aside Standing Order 185, Mrs. D'Amours (Mirabel), together with Mr. Villeneuve (Berthier), Mrs. David (Gouin) and Mrs. Roy (Arthabaska), moved:

THAT the National Assembly demand that the Federal Government ensure that the Canadian Food Inspection Agency apply its regulation on cheese compositional standards using the same definition of diafiltered milk as the Canada Border Services Agency, namely, a protein concentrate.

The question was put on this motion, and a recorded division was thereupon demanded.

The motion was carried on the following vote:

By leave of the Assembly to set aside Standing Order 185, Mrs. Anglade, Minister of Economy, Science and Innovation, together with Mr. Therrien (Sanguinet) and Mr. Legault, Leader of the Second Opposition Group, moved:

THAT the National Assembly honour the memory of Mr. Bernard Lamarre, a great entrepreneur and "builder" in the field of consulting engineering;

THAT it highlight his contribution to Québec engineering and to the Québec economy.

By leave of the Assembly, a debate arose thereon.

At the request of Mr. Gendron, Third Vice-President, the Assembly observed a moment of silence.

Mrs. Massé (Sainte-Marie-Saint-Jacques) moved a motion concerning natural gas consumption in Québec; this motion could not be debated for want of unanimous consent.
