Bill 147

An Act concerning the prohibition against bringing certain actions related to the operation of off-highway vehicles on trails forming part of the interregional network

Introduction

Introduced by Madam Véronyque Tremblay Minister for Transport

EXPLANATORY NOTES

This bill proposes setting 1 January 2020 as the date on which the prohibition against bringing certain civil actions related to the operation of off-highway vehicles on trails forming part of the interregional network ceases to have effect.

Bill 147

AN ACT CONCERNING THE PROHIBITION AGAINST BRINGING CERTAIN ACTIONS RELATED TO THE OPERATION OF OFF-HIGHWAY VEHICLES ON TRAILS FORMING PART OF THE INTERREGIONAL NETWORK

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- **1.** Section 87.1 of the Act respecting off-highway vehicles (chapter V-1.2) is amended by replacing "1 December 2017" in the first paragraph by "1 January 2020".
- **2.** This Act comes into force on (*insert the date of assent to this Act*).
