The Assembly proceeded to Oral Question Period.

Motions Without Notice

Mr. Arcand, Leader of the Official Opposition, together with Mrs. Fournier (Marie-Victorin), Mrs. Massé, Leader of the Third Opposition Group, and Mr. Ouellette (Chomedey), moved a motion on the 18,000 Regular Skilled Worker Program files; this motion could not be debated for want of unanimous consent.

By leave of the Assembly to set aside Standing Order 185, Mr. Gaudreault (Jonquière), together with Mrs. McCann, Minister of Health and Social Services, Mr. Zanetti (Jean-Lesage) and Mr. Ouellette (Chomedey), moved:

THAT the National Assembly ask the Québec Government to put an end, as soon as possible, to remunerating physicians for overseeing the medical activities of nurse practitioners specialized in front-line care.

The question was put on this motion, and a recorded division was thereupon demanded.

THAT the National Assembly proudly highlight the 50th anniversary of ÉNAP, the Université du Québec network's school of public administration, and that it pay tribute to its contractual and regular professors;

THAT the Assembly also congratulate the thousands of ÉNAP graduates who chose to obtain the best possible knowledge so as to ensure quality public services in Québec.
