The Assembly proceeded to Oral Question Period.

Deferred Divisions

The Assembly took the division, which had been deferred at the sitting of 11 April 2019, on the motion moved by Mr. Girard, Minister of Finance, for the passage of Bill 3, An Act to establish a single school tax rate.

The motion was carried on the following vote:

Accordingly, Bill 3 was passed.

Motions Without Notice

By leave of the Assembly to set aside Standing Order 185, Mr. Lemieux (Saint-Jean), together with Mr. Fortin (Pontiac), Mr. Zanetti (Jean-Lesage), Mr. Gaudreault (Jonquière), Mr. Ouellette (Chomedey) and Mrs. Fournier (Marie-Victorin), moved:

THAT the National Assembly mark the 70th anniversary of the Association de la paralysie cérébrale du Québec, the oldest association of its kind in North America, now headquartered in Saint-Jean-sur-Richelieu;

THAT it recall that 22,000 Quebecers have cerebral palsy and that another 140 cases are diagnosed every year;

THAT, on behalf of all Quebecers, it thank the APCQ, which for 70 years has been helping the families of people with cerebral palsy in addition to contributing, as a founding member, to the Université Laval Research Chair in Cerebral Palsy;

THAT, lastly, it highlight the launching of the farreaching green butterfly cerebral palsy awareness campaign, which will run throughout this 70th anniversary year.

THAT it reiterate its commitment to fighting all forms of hatred and racial, ethnic and religious discrimination and that it reiterate the importance it attaches to building a more just, more peaceful and more egalitarian world.

THAT the National Assembly take note of the mental health crisis in Québec;

THAT it acknowledge the urgent needs of our mental health care system and suicide prevention system;

THAT it recognize that improving prevention and care in the field of mental health is a national priority;

THAT it ask the Government to broaden the scope of the consultation announced on this subject, so as to include more civil society groups and allow more extensive, in-depth reflection.

THAT, lastly, the Québec Government support France at this difficult time.
