By leave of the Assembly to set aside Standing Order 185, Mr. Dubé, Minister of Health and Social Services, together with Ms. Montpetit (Maurice-Richard), Mr. Nadeau-Dubois, House Leader of the Second Opposition Group, Mr. Arseneau (Îles-de-la-Madeleine), Ms. Fournier (Marie-Victorin) and Mr. LeBel (Rimouski), moved:

THAT the National Assembly pay tribute to Mr. Claude Castonguay, Member for Louis-Hébert from 1970 to 1973, Minister of Health, Minister of Family and Social Welfare and Minister of Social Affairs, in particular recognized as the father of the Québec Health Insurance Plan;

THAT it acknowledge that Ontario has already passed legislation to cap food delivery fees;

THAT it ask the CAQ government to table, as soon as possible, a bill to cap the delivery fees charged to restaurant owners at 15% and the overall charges to 20% for the duration of the public health emergency.
