#### **Government Bills**

Passage in Principle

Mr. Lafrenière, Minister Responsible for Indigenous Affairs, moved that Bill 79, An Act to authorize the communication of personal information to the families of Indigenous children who went missing or died after being admitted to an institution, do now pass in principle.

A debate arose thereon.

Mr. Picard, First Vice-President, interrupted the debate and informed the Assembly that he had received two requests for debate upon adjournment to be held on Thursday, 15 April 2021:

- the first, on a question from Ms. Robitaille (Bourassa-Sauvé) to the Government about emergency shelters for people experiencing homelessness;
- the second, on a question from Ms. Perry Mélançon (Gaspé) to Ms. Lecours, Minister for the Economy, about local content in government supply contracts.

The debate continued.

By leave of the Assembly to set aside Standing Order 218, Members took the floor to comment on this motion after the reply of Mr. Lafrenière, Minister Responsible for Indigenous Affairs.

#### **Business Standing in the Name of Members in Opposition**

Mr. Tanguay (LaFontaine) moved:

THAT the National Assembly recognize that Québec is currently experiencing an unprecedented crisis in the number of available spaces its educational childcare services can offer;

THAT it acknowledge that the waiting list has drastically increased, with over 51,000 children from across Québec now waiting for a space;

THAT it emphasize that the difficulty of obtaining a childcare space leads parents, mainly women, to make the tough choice of taking unpaid leave;

THAT it recognize that this crisis in childcare spaces accentuates the inequity gap between women and men;

THAT it note that many essential service jobs are femaledominated professions and that Québec depends on the work these women perform, especially during these pandemic times;

THAT it emphasize that it is almost exclusively women who hold early childcare educator positions and that the childcare service network currently needs several thousand more qualified educators in order for it to be able to operate properly;

THAT it recall that recent negotiations with the providers of home educational services were arduous and resulted in several closures of these childcare facilities;

THAT it acknowledge that the CAQ government's third budget does not contain a plan nor the sums necessary to get Québec families out of this childcare space predicament;

THAT it demand that the CAQ government recognize the gravity of this childcare space crisis;

THAT, lastly, it demand that the CAQ government mobilize all government departments and agencies in order to implement an emergency plan as quickly as possible.

Mr. Picard, First Vice-President, informed the Assembly of the allocation of speaking time for the proceedings with respect to this limited debate: 10 minutes to the mover of the motion for his reply; 52 minutes to the parliamentary group forming the Government; 31 minutes 39 seconds to the parliamentary group forming the Official Opposition; 11 minutes 18 seconds to the Second Opposition Group; 9 minutes 3 seconds to the Third Opposition Group; and 1 minute 30 seconds to each independent Member. However, if only one independent Member takes part in the debate, that Member's speaking time is 2 minutes. Within this framework, any time not used by independent Members or by a parliamentary group shall be redistributed among the parliamentary groups in the proportions established above. Lastly, individual addresses shall not be limited.

The debate arose thereon.

The question was put on this motion; in accordance with the motion carried by the Assembly on 13 April 2021, a vote was held in accordance with the procedure for recorded divisions.
