THAT the National Assembly acknowledge the fact that 80% of the members of the Quebec Collective Society for the Rights of Makers of Sound and Video Recordings are self-producing artist entrepreneurs;

THAT it acknowledge that these self-producing artists do not have access to the SODEC programs reserved for "recognized producers" and are penalized as a result;

THAT it note the increasing number of self-producing artists in Québec's music sector;

THAT it recognize that an open letter calling for greater recognition of self-producing artists entitled "Les artistes méritent plus que des bonbons" has been supported by 123 signatories since its publication on 26 May 2021;

THAT, lastly, the National Assembly ask the Minister of Culture and Communications to make the necessary changes to increase self-producing artists' eligibility under SODEC's funding programs.

THAT this motion be an order of the National Assembly.
