An Act to regulate the distribution of advertising items

## EXPLANATORY NOTES

This bill provides that the distribution of advertising items is authorized on a property only if the pictogram prescribed by government regulation is displayed there.

Anyone who distributes advertising items on a property where no pictogram is displayed and anyone other than a property's owner or occupant or a person authorized by either of them who displays such a pictogram is subject to a fine.

Lastly, under the bill, advertising items must be distributed in plastic-free packaging that can be recycled without first having to be separated from its contents.

## AN ACT TO REGULATE THE DISTRIBUTION OF ADVERTISING ITEMS

## THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The distribution of advertising items is authorized on a property only if the pictogram prescribed by government regulation is displayed there.

In the case of an offence under the first paragraph, the fine is not less than $\$ 500$ and not more than $\$ 1,000$.
2. Anyone other than a property's owner or occupant or a person authorized by either of them who displays such a pictogram on a property is guilty of an offence and is liable to a fine of not less than $\$ 100$ and not more than $\$ 500$.
3. Advertising items must be distributed in plastic-free packaging that can be recycled without first having to be separated from its contents.

A government regulation determines the composition of the packaging used for the distribution of advertising items.
4. The Minister of the Environment and the Fight Against Climate Change is responsible for the administration of this Act.
5. This Act comes into force on (insert the date that is six months after the date of assent to this Act).
