#### **Motions Without Notice**

THAT it condemn the public display of contempt and the lack of consideration from Air Canada and its president with respect to the French language and culture of Québec;

THAT it reiterate the importance of adopting strong, structural measures, in particular the application of the *Charter of the French language* to businesses with federal charters, such as Air Canada, to stop and reverse the anglicization of Québec, especially in the metropolis. THAT the National Assembly also demand that the federal departments and agencies situated in the territory of Québec be subject exclusively to the *Charter of the French language*.
