EXPLANATORY NOTES

This bill amends the Act to proclaim Tartan Day to adopt the “Plaid du Québec” tartan numbered 1949 in the Scottish Register of Tartans as the Québec tartan.

AN ACT RESPECTING THE QUÉBEC TARTAN

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

ACT TO PROCLAIM TARTAN DAY

1. The title of the Act to proclaim Tartan Day (chapter J-0.3) is amended by adding “and to declare the Québec Tartan” at the end.

2. The preamble to the Act is amended by adding the following paragraph at the end:

“Whereas the “Plaid du Québec” tartan numbered 1949 in the Scottish Register of Tartans bears the colours of Québec’s coat of arms: blue for the fess azure, green for the sprig of sugar maple with triple leaf vert, red for the fess gules, gold for the lion passant and for the royal crown, and white for the silver scroll bearing the motto “JE ME SOUVIENS”;

3. The Act is amended by inserting the following section after section 1:

“**1.1.** The “Plaid du Québec” tartan numbered 1949 in the Scottish Register of Tartans is the Québec tartan.”

FINAL PROVISION
