Motions Without Notice

THAT the National Assembly reiterate its trust in the Anti-Collusion Unit created on 16 February 2011 and whose mission is:

- to ensure the coordination of actions regarding the prevention of and the fight against corruption in relation to contracts in the public sector;
- to receive, process and examine reports of reprehensible acts in order that they be given a proper follow-up;
- to direct and coordinate the activities of all audit and investigative teams composed of its own staff members or those appointed by the Government;

And, lastly, that it recall that this Unit has full powers to investigate the comments made by Mr. Jacques Duchesneau during his hearing before the Committee on Public Administration with regard to Hydro-Québec.

By leave of the Assembly, a debate arose thereon.

Government Bills

Passage in Principle

By leave of the Assembly to set aside Standing Order 236, Mrs. Courchesne, Minister responsible for Government Administration and Chair of the Conseil du trésor, moved, —That Bill 23, An Act to amend various pension plans in the public sector, do now pass in principle.

After debate thereon, the motion was carried and Bill 23 was accordingly passed in principle.

Mr. Paquet, Minister for Finance, moved that Bill 23 be referred for clause-byclause consideration to the Committee on Public Finance.

The motion was carried.

Mr. Paquet, Minister for Finance, moved, —That Bill 7, An Act to amend various legislative provisions concerning the financial sector, do now pass in principle.

A debate arose thereon.

By leave of the Assembly to set aside Standing Orders 53 and 59, Mr. Rebello (La Prairie) tabled the following:

A document entitled "Coalition pour la protection des investisseurs – Notes et commentaires sur le projet de loi n° 7".

The debate being concluded, the motion was carried and Bill 7 was accordingly passed in principle.

The Assembly resumed the debate, which had been adjourned on 28 September 2011, on the motion by Mr. Simard, Minister for Natural Resources and Wildlife, for the passage in principle of Bill 14, An Act respecting the development of mineral resources in keeping with the principles of sustainable development.

The proceedings resumed at 3.00 o'clock p.m.

The Assembly continued the debate on the motion by Mr. Simard, Minister for Natural Resources and Wildlife, for the passage in principle of Bill 14, An Act respecting the development of mineral resources in keeping with the principles of sustainable development.

The debate was adjourned in the name of Mr. St-Arnaud (Chambly).
