Motion by the Member for Jean-Talon:

THAT the Committee on Health and Social Services hold special consultations beginning on Wednesday, 29 May 2013, on the Parti Québécois Government's draft rules repealing the provision that prohibits the sale, service and consumption of alcoholic beverages inside gaming areas and that, for this purpose, the Committee hear the Minister of Minister of Finance and the Economy, the national public health director, the Association des centres de traitement des dépendances du Québec and the Minister of Health and Social Services, as well as any person it may deem necessary to summon;

THAT the presentation by the Minister of Finance and the Economy last no longer than 10 minutes and the exchanges with the Committee members last no longer than 90 minutes; THAT the presentation by the national public health director and by the Association des centres de traitement des dépendances du Québec last 10 minutes respectively and that the exchanges with the Committee members last no longer than 50 minutes respectively;

THAT the presentation by the Minister of Health and Social Services last no longer than 10 minutes and the exchanges with the Committee members last no longer than 90 minutes;

THAT the presentation by each of the other speakers, if any, last no longer than 10 minutes and the exchanges with the Committee members last no longer than 50 minutes;

THAT the Committee report to the Assembly no later than 12 June 2013, unless the Committee decides otherwise;

We ask the Minister of International Relations, La Francophonie and External Trade to provide us with the following information in reference to the mission carried out by the Premier and the Minister for Canadian Intergovernmental Affairs and Sovereignist Governance in London and Scotland in January 2013:

- 1. The list of persons who accompanied the Premier and the Minister;
- 2. The overall mission expenditure charged to the Secrétariat aux affaires intergouvernementales canadiennes, the Executive Council, the Ministère des Relations internationals, de la Francophonie et du Commerce extérieur and, if applicable, to the Québec Delegation in London;
- 3. The mission's agenda;
- 4. The list of persons with whom meetings were held as well as a copy of their business cards;
- 5. The complete itinerary;
- 6. The exchange of correspondence between Premier Salmond and the Premier of Québec, as well as the exchange of e-mails between their respective offices since 4 September 2012.

Last 7 February, during the examination of the estimates of expenditure, I asked for details of the figures as at 31 March 2012, concerning the breakdown of the pension plans and the Retirement Plans Sinking Fund (RPSF) liabilities for each of the private and public employee plans, with the active participants and beneficiaries categories presented separately.

This data is especially important as it will allow me to continue my reflection on the future of Québec pension plans.

Also, could the Minister responsible for the administration of legislation respecting the professions be able to provide this data as soon as possible?

To the Minister responsible for the Charter of the French language:

Considering the responsiveness on the part of all the parliamentarians present when the Fondation des sourds du Québec came before the Committee on Culture and Education within the framework of the hearings on Bill 14, how does the Minister responsible for the Charter of the French language intend to include Québec Sign Language (QSL) in a renewed Charter of the French language?

(12) Mr. Dubé (Lévis) – 7 May 2013

To the Minister of Finance and the Economy:

Since 19 April 2013, the \$920 million figure referring to total budget cuts has been mentioned by several media sources following interviews given by the Premier. Nowhere in the budget documents of last November was the \$920 million figure explicitly mentioned, nor was it mentioned in those of the economic update last March.

I would ask the Minister of Finance:

- to provide me with the baseline for this amount;
- to send me the total budget cuts carried out by the Parti Québécois Government since it came to power, as well as the total cuts planned for 2013-2104;
- to table the detailed list of budget cuts carried out by the Government since it was formed, including the breakdown of each cut for each department and public agency;
- to table the detailed list of budget cuts planned by the Government for the 2013-2014 fiscal year, including the breakdown of each cut for each department and public agency.
