An Act to proclaim Aboriginal History Month

EXPLANATORY NOTES

The purpose of this bill is to proclaim the month of June as Aboriginal History Month.

Bill 44

AN ACT TO PROCLAIM ABORIGINAL HISTORY MONTH

AS Aboriginal peoples have inhabited Québec territory since time immemorial;

AS the National Assembly has recognized, by resolutions adopted on 20 March 1985 and 30 May 1989, the existence of 11 Aboriginal nations;

AS the role played by these nations in the history and development of Québec is not properly understood by the people of Québec;

AS recognition of that role will contribute to the empowerment and pride of Aboriginal peoples;

AS proclaiming an Aboriginal History Month will increase the public's knowledge of the role played by Aboriginal peoples in the history and development of Québec;

AS this increased public knowledge will promote openness to pluralism and foster closer intercultural relations with Aboriginal nations;

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- **1.** The month of June is hereby proclaimed Aboriginal History Month.
- **2.** This Act comes into force on 21 June 2013.
