I would ask the Minister of Finance:

- to provide me with the baseline for this amount;
- to send me the total budget cuts carried out by the Parti Québécois Government since it came to power, as well as the total cuts planned for 2013-2104:
- to table the detailed list of budget cuts carried out by the Government since it was formed, including the breakdown of each cut for each department and public agency;
- to table the detailed list of budget cuts planned by the Government for the 2013-2014 fiscal year, including the breakdown of each cut for each department and public agency.
