EXPLANATORY NOTES

The purpose of this bill is to exempt a regional county municipality from the obligation to obtain government authorizations, in particular with regard to the environment, which cause delays in work required to restore normal water flow in a watercourse if the regional county municipality is informed of the presence of an obstacle that threatens the safety of persons or property.

LEGISLATION AMENDED BY THIS BILL:

AN ACT TO AMEND THE MUNICIPAL POWERS ACT TO ALLOW REGIONAL COUNTY MUNICIPALITIES TO CARRY OUT CERTAIN WORK WITHOUT DELAY

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Section 105 of the Municipal Powers Act (chapter C-47.1) is amended by inserting the following paragraph after the first paragraph:

“The work is exempt from the application of section 22 of the Environment Quality Act (chapter Q-2) and from the obligation to obtain any other government authorization that would cause the work to be delayed.”
