EXPLANATORY NOTES

This bill amends the Food Products Act to withdraw the provisions that prohibit mixing a dairy product or constituent of a dairy product with a dairy product substitute, and preparing, offering for sale, selling, delivering, processing or keeping, displaying or transporting for the purpose of sale any dairy product substitute that is not designated by a regulation of the Government.

AN ACT TO ADDRESS THE FINDINGS OF THE PANEL ESTABLISHED UNDER THE AGREEMENT ON INTERNAL TRADE REGARDING SECTIONS 7.1 AND 7.2 OF THE FOOD PRODUCTS ACT

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1.** Sections 7.1 and 7.2 of the Food Products Act (chapter P-29) are repealed.
- 2.** Section 40 of the Act is amended by striking out paragraphs *b.1* and *b.2*.
- 3.** This Act comes into force on (*insert the date of assent to this Act*).
