EXPLANATORY NOTES

This bill removes the provision of the Charter of Ville de Montréal that requires the mayor of Ville de Montréal to designate a minimum of 7 and a maximum of 11 council members to sit on the executive committee.

AN ACT TO AMEND THE CHARTER OF VILLE DE MONTRÉAL AS CONCERNS THE COMPOSITION OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1.** Section 22 of the Charter of Ville de Montréal (chapter C-11.4) is amended by striking out the second sentence of the first paragraph.
