THAT pursuant to Standing Orders 315 to 321, the Assembly rule on the conduct of the Member for Châteauguay and Minister of Municipal Affairs and Land Occupancy, who allegedly was in contempt of Parliament when he invoked sections 247 and 250 of Bill 28, An Act mainly to implement certain provisions of the Budget Speech of 4 June 2014 and return to a balanced budget in 2015-2016, before they were passed by the Assembly;
