The Assembly was called to order at 2.13 o'clock p.m.

At the request of the President, the Assembly observed a moment of reflection in memory of Mr. Jacques Parizeau, former Premier of Québec, who passed away on 1 June 2015.

By unanimous consent of the Assembly to set aside its rules of procedure, Mr. Péladeau, Leader of the Official Opposition, together with Mr. Couillard, Premier, Mr. Legault, Leader of the Second Opposition Group, and Mrs. David (Gouin), moved:

THAT the National Assembly pay tribute to Mr. Jacques Parizeau, Premier of Québec from 1994 to 1996, Minister of Finance from 1976 to 1984, Member for L'Assomption from 1976 to 1984, then from 1989 to 1996, and economic and financial adviser to the Québec Government, for his outstanding contribution to the development of modern-day Québec;

THAT it recommend that the building housing the Head Office of the Caisse de dépôt et placement du Québec in Montréal henceforth be called Édifice Jacques-Parizeau to honour his memory.

Mr. Couillard, Premier, Mr. Péladeau, Leader of the Official Opposition, Mr. Legault, Leader of the Second Opposition Group, Mrs. David (Gouin), Mr. Lisée (Rosemont), Mrs. Ouellet (Vachon), Mr. Kotto (Bourget), Mr. Gendron, Third Vice-President, and Mr. Paradis, Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, and the President spoke to this motion.

The motion was then carried.
