(5) Mr. Therrien (Terrebonne) – **11 June 2008**To the Chair of the Conseil du trésor:

Following the tabling of the Bouchard-Taylor Report, an advertising campaign was undertaken by the Government and full pages were bought in Québec's major newspapers.

Would the Minister provide detailed answers to the following questions:

What is the breakdown of expenses of this advertising campaign, including the direct cost of the purchase of each advertising space, the cost of media placement, as well as the amount paid to the communications agency that created the publicity?

Which communications agency was given the mandate to create this publicity?

What is the complete list of newspapers in which the publicity was published, including the publication date or dates?

(8) Mrs. Méthé (Saint-Jean) – **20 June 2008** To the Minister of Transport :

Following the municipal amalgamations, the Ministère des Transports had indicated that a comprehensive plan to improve traffic signs along highways had been put into place, seven years ago. However, seven years later, the amounts still have not been set aside to provide the population with adequate information panels on Québec highways.

In the electoral division of Saint-Jean, on Highway 35, the situation raises concerns, as the letters are practically illegible to automobile drivers. The safety of users should be taken into consideration. Furthermore, we must also consider that it is Québec's image that appears on these signs, particularly owing to the geographical location of the city of Saint-Jean, which is an important city for visitors hailing from Vermont and who are entering Québec.

Would the Minister of Transport confirm the existence of this restoration plan?

Would the Minister of Transport give us the exact date on which this situation will be corrected, principally in the strategic areas and where they are most deteriorated?

(9) Mr. Francoeur (Portneuf) – **20 June 2008**To the Minister responsible for the Capitale-Nationale region :

During the examination of the estimates of expenditure 2008-2009 concerning the estimates of the Ministère de la Santé et des Services sociaux (3): Promotion and Development component of the Capitale-Nationale, I asked the Minister if he could provide me with more information regarding a doubtful debt of \$634,500 appearing in the amounts granted in 2007-2008 to the Bureau de la Capitale-Nationale. No answer has yet been provided regarding this request.
