



## EXTRAIT DE PÉTITION

Je dépose l'extrait d'une pétition adressée à l'Assemblée nationale, signée par 761 pétitionnaires.

**Désignation : Citoyens et citoyennes du Québec**

**Les faits invoqués sont les suivants :**

**CONSIDERING THAT** all Quebecers with Canadian citizenship of age 18 shall be better protected by modifying two laws;

**Et l'intervention réclamée se résume ainsi :**

We, the undersigned, ask the National Assembly to modify two laws as follows:

- **Matrimonial community regime:** If one spouse dies, the community patrimony shall be administered by the surviving married spouse and not immediately divided 50% - 50% as is required by the current law, regardless of the provisions in the will of the deceased spouse. After making an inventory, the surviving spouse shall have the right to use all property until her or his death and then the distribution shall begin. Note: this applies only for spouses who did not execute a marriage contract;
- **Delay to appeal from a judgment:** Thirty (30) days to file an appeal from a judgment is too short and it should be extended to six (6) months. If a party makes an appeal after thirty (30) days she or he has to advance a retainer for legal fees of fifteen thousand (\$15,000.00) or more to open a new court file.
