Bill 93

An Act to amend the Act respecting the National Assembly to reflect changes made to the delimitation of electoral divisions in accordance with the Notice of the establishment of the list of electoral divisions dated 12 October 2011

EXPLANATORY NOTES

This bill amends the Act respecting the National Assembly to entitle the Member domiciled within the electoral division of Charlevoix—Côte-de-Beaupré and more than 50 kilometres from the Parliament Building by the shortest road to the reimbursement of expenses for lodgings in the territory of Ville de Québec or in the immediate vicinity even though the Member's domicile is located in an electoral division adjacent to the territory of Ville de Québec. The bill gives effect to an agreement in principle by the members of the Office of the National Assembly.

AN ACT TO AMEND THE ACT RESPECTING THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY TO REFLECT CHANGES MADE TO THE DELIMITATION OF ELECTORAL DIVISIONS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE NOTICE OF THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE LIST OF ELECTORAL DIVISIONS DATED 12 OCTOBER 2011

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- **1.** Section 104 of the Act respecting the National Assembly (chapter A-23.1) is amended by adding ", or of the Member domiciled within the electoral division of Charlevoix–Côte-de-Beaupré and more than 50 kilometres from the Parliament Building by the shortest road" at the end of subparagraph 4 of the first paragraph.
- **2.** This Act comes into force on (*insert the date of assent to this Act*) but has effect from 1 April 2015.
