- (cc) Motion by the Minister of Justice :

THAT the National Assembly:

- I** Concur in the position and justifications given by the government and stipulated in its new answer to the report from the Comité de la rémunération des juges de la Cour du Québec et des cours municipales for the period of 2004-2007, tabled before the Assembly on 16 October 2007 by the Government House Leader on behalf of the Minister of Justice; and
- II** Concerning the justices of the Court of Québec:
1. Approve Recommendations 1, 2 and 4 issued by the Comité de la rémunération des juges de la Cour du Québec et des cours municipales for the period of 2004-2007, in its report tabled at the National Assembly on 28 October 2004 and whose sessional paper number is 1256-20041028;
 2. Amend Recommendations 3 and 5 of the Comité in order that:
 - a) the indemnity for expenses incurred in the performance of the duties of the justice responsible for training be set at \$6000 (Recommendation 3);
 - b) Recommendation 5 also includes the retroactive amount to be paid to justices of the Cour du Québec following the implementation of the new answer and the present resolution;

III Concerning the municipal court justices:

1. Approve Recommendations 1, 3, 4, 6, 8, 12 and 13 issued by the Comité de la rémunération des juges de la Cour du Québec et des cours municipales for the period of 2004-2007, in its report tabled at the National Assembly on 28 October 2004 and whose sessional paper number is 1256-20041028;

Specify, as regards Recommendation 13, that the reimbursement paid to justices of the municipal courts of Laval, Montréal and Québec, as a contribution to the payment of their lawyers' fees, is carried out without any form of admission regarding the competence of the Comité to recommend this payment;

2. Amend Recommendations 5, 7 and 9 of the Comité in order that:
 - a) the supplementary remuneration of presiding justices be set at 8 % of the maximum annual salary of associate justices and that of associate presiding justices at 6 % of the maximum annual salary of associate justices (Recommendation 5);
 - b) an amount of \$5000 for expenses incurred in the performance of his duties be provided for the municipal justice responsible for training municipal justices (Recommendation 7);
 - c) Recommendation 7 includes all municipal justices who are remunerated per sitting, including interim, pro tempore and substitute justices, and that a municipal justice be eligible, the year of his appointment, to the expenses incurred in the performance of his duties established according to the amounts proposed in Recommendation 7, proportionately to the number of months during which he will have exercised his legal duties, the month of his appointment being considered as a full month;
 - d) Recommendation 9 also includes the retroactive amount to be paid to the justices of the municipal courts of Laval, Montréal and Québec following the implementation of the new answer and the present resolution;

3. Reject Recommendations 2, 10 and 11 and allocate to municipal justices who are remunerated per sitting, beginning on 1 January 2005, a supplementary annual amount of 13 % of their salary, as compensation for the value of a pension plan.

(dd)Motion by the Member for Rouyn-Noranda–Témiscamingue :

THAT the National Assembly of Québec demand that the Government immediately put in place the necessary measures to adequately support all workers having permanently or temporarily lost their jobs as well as the necessary measures to cope with possible job losses in our forest regions linked to the upcoming forest industry consolidation announced by the Minister for next December.
