EXPLANATORY NOTES

This bill amends the Professional Syndicates Act in order to eliminate the Canadian citizenship requirement for members of a syndicate's administrative council or personnel.

The bill also removes the requirement for a syndicate to comprise at least 15 members, all Canadian citizens.

LEGISLATION AMENDED BY THIS BILL:

AN ACT TO AMEND THE PROFESSIONAL SYNDICATES ACT TO ELIMINATE THE CANADIAN CITIZENSHIP REQUIREMENT FOR MEMBERS OF A SYNDICATE'S ADMINISTRATIVE COUNCIL OR PERSONNEL

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1.** Section 1 of the Professional Syndicates Act (chapter S-40) is amended
 - (1) by striking out “, Canadian citizens,” in subsection 1;
 - (2) by striking out “, nationality” wherever it appears in subparagraph *c* of subsection 2.
- 2.** Section 5 of the Act is amended by striking out “nationality,” in paragraph *b*.
- 3.** Section 8 of the Act is amended by striking out the first paragraph.
- 4.** Section 26 of the Act is amended, in the first paragraph,
 - (1) by striking out “who are Canadian citizens and in good standing” in subparagraph *b*;
 - (2) by striking out subparagraph *c*.
- 5.** This Act comes into force on (*insert the date of assent to this Act*).
