## **Bill 232**

(Private)

AN ACT TO PROHIBIT A PUBLIC INSTITUTION WITHIN THE MEANING OF THE ACT RESPECTING HEALTH SERVICES AND SOCIAL SERVICES FROM OPERATING A PAID PARKING LOT IN THE TERRITORY OF VILLE DE BELŒIL

AS, on 22 October 2007, Ville de Belœil gratuitously transferred a vacant lot to the Corporation d'hébergement du Québec for construction of the Centre local de services communautaires des Patriotes Belœil and an adjoining parking lot;

AS, on 11 January 2012, the Centre de santé et de services sociaux Richelieu-Yamaska adopted parking rate-setting policies for its various institutions in the region, thereby creating a paid parking lot at the Centre de santé et de services sociaux Richelieu-Yamaska:

AS, through the 22 October 2007 transfer, the people of Ville de Belœil made a significant contribution to the project and should not, under any circumstances, have to pay additional costs for using the said parking lot;

## THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- **1.** Despite any contrary provision, a public institution within the meaning of the Act respecting health services and social services (chapter S-4.2) may not directly or indirectly require or receive payment for the use of an offstreet parking space in the territory of Ville de Belœil.
- **2.** This Act comes into force on (insert the date of assent to this Act).
