The Assembly proceeded to Oral Question Period.

Motions Without Notice

By leave of the Assembly to set aside Standing Order 185, Mr. Leitão (Robert-Baldwin), together with Mr. Girard, Minister of Finance, Mr. Ouellet (René-Lévesque), Mr. Zanetti (Jean-Lesage) and Mr. Ouellette (Chomedey), moved:

THAT the National Assembly vigorously denounce the Supreme Court of Canada's decision authorizing the Federal Government to put in place a Canada-wide securities commission;

THAT the Assembly reiterate the importance of ensuring that Québec's jurisdiction over securities is fully respected and that it demand that the Federal Government implement the necessary guarantees for that purpose;

THAT the Assembly ask the Québec Government not to join the federal plan and to maintain the Autorité des marchés financiers as the guardian of Québec securities regulations.

The question was put on this motion, and a recorded division was thereupon demanded.

THAT the National Assembly express its solidarity with and its support for the Franco-Ontarian community and the Member for Glengarry-Prescott-Russell, Amanda Simard, in their fight for the survival of their French-language institutions, including the Université de l'Ontario français project;

THAT it denounce this new violation of the rights of a francophone minority community in Canada;

THAT it note that the survival of the French language continues to be tenuous and requires constant vigilance;

THAT on the December 1 day of action, the Franco-Ontarian flag be flown atop one of the National Assembly's towers.

THAT the National Assembly ask the Québec Government to consider children for whom child support is being paid as the exclusive beneficiaries of these amounts and that, consequently, it act diligently and fairly so that child support ceases to be considered income for the receiving parent in calculating social assistance benefits and determining eligibility for legal aid, financial assistance for education expenses and housing support.

The question was put on this motion, and a recorded division was thereupon demanded.

By leave of the Assembly to set aside Standing Order 185, Mrs. LeBel, Minister of Justice, together with Mrs. Thériault (Anjou–Louis-Riel), Mrs. Hivon (Joliette), Mr. Leduc (Hochelaga-Maisonneuve) and Mr. Ouellette (Chomedey), moved:

THAT the National Assembly denounce the provisions introduced in Bill C-86, which offer less protection than that provided for in Québec's consumer credit legislation and which will create confusion as to the rules applicable to consumer credit and to the distribution of certain insurance contracts;

THAT it ask the Federal Government that C-86 provisions affecting these two sectors not apply where Québec standards for the same purposes are already provided for;

THAT it reaffirm that consumer protection is a responsibility that falls squarely within Québec's jurisdiction, as the Supreme Court of Canada recognized in *BMO v. Marcotte*;

THAT, lastly, the National Assembly reiterate that any action the Federal Government takes must respect Québec's constitutional jurisdiction with respect to property and civil rights as well as decisions made by Québec in the interest of Québec consumers.

THAT the National Assembly severely censure the Coalition avenir Québec Government for its intention to lower immigration targets over the coming years.

At the end of her speech, Mrs. David (Marguerite-Bourgeoys) moved the following motion stating a grievance:

THAT the National Assembly severely censure the CAQ Government, which is completely abandoning the most vulnerable members of our society and ignoring the social services needs of citizens and community organizations at a time when it has major budgetary surpluses.
