THAT the National Assembly recognize that clauses providing for differences in treatment among employees are a key issue where intergenerational equity is concerned;

THAT the National Assembly ask the Government to table a bill, as soon as possible, to correct the *Act respecting labour standards*, which allows for the perpetual renewal of the clauses providing for differences in treatment currently in force, so that the use of such clauses is truly prohibited once and for all.
