




# COMMENT WRITING GUIDE

## Who may write a comment?

Any interested person may write a comment.

## What can be commented on?

Comments may be submitted in relation to most parliamentary committee mandates, or to bills once they have been introduced in the National Assembly. The presence of the  icon next to a mandate means that it is possible to comment on it.

## Who reads the comments?

Comments are made available to all parliamentarians, including parliamentary committee members, as well as their collaborators.

## How to write a comment?

Comments must be:



**concise and clear;**



**relevant and related to the mandate;**  
they may include facts, opinions  
or arguments;



**respectful,** free of defamatory, injurious  
or obscene language, or language that  
incites hatred or violence.

Comments must comply with the above rules to be admissible.

## Publication of comments

Comments received are confidential. However, they may exceptionally be tabled in parliamentary committee or attached to a report tabled in the National Assembly, in full or in summarized form.
