THAT the organization of proceedings be entrusted to the Committee's steering committee, including the preparation of the schedule according to any request for changes made by individuals and organizations;

THAT a period of 15 minutes be set aside for opening statements, allocated as follows: 7 minutes 30 seconds to the parliamentary group forming the Government, 5 minutes to the Official Opposition, 1 minute 15 seconds to the Second Opposition Group and 1 minute 15 seconds to the Third Opposition Group;

THAT the presentation by each individual or organization last no longer than 10 minutes and the exchange with the Committee members last no longer than 35 minutes, allocated as follows: 17 minutes 30 seconds to the parliamentary group forming the Government, 11 minutes 40 seconds to the Official Opposition, 2 minutes 55 seconds to the Second Opposition Group and 2 minutes 55 seconds to the Third Opposition Group;

THAT the Minister for Health and Social Services be a member of the said Committee during its proceedings with respect to this order of reference

(dd) Motion by the Minister of Justice:

THAT the National Assembly:

Approve the recommendations of the report of the committee on the remuneration of judges for 2016-2019 concerning the pension plan of presiding justices of the peace, dated 20 August 2018 and tabled in the National Assembly on 6 December 2018, specifying that partial reimbursement of experts' and lawyers' fees incurred by the Conférence des juges de paix magistrats du Québec is granted without admissions as to the Committee on the remuneration of judges' power to make such recommendations and as to evaluation of the amount determined by the Committee for reimbursement purposes.
