**Appropriation Bills** 

By leave of the Assembly, Mr. Dubé, Minister Responsible for Government Administration and Chair of the Conseil du trésor, moved the introduction, passage in principle and passage of Bill 24, Appropriation Act No. 2, 2019–2020.

The question was put on the motion, and a recorded division was thereupon demanded.

Accordingly, Bill 24, Appropriation Act No. 2, 2019–2020, was passed.

THAT the motion moved by the Member for Robert-Baldwin be amended as follows:

By adding the following paragraph after the second paragraph: "THAT the SAQ privatization scenario be excluded from this mandate;".

The amendment motion was negatived on the following vote:

This motion reads as follows:

THAT the National Assembly instruct the Committee on Public Finance to examine the report by PricewaterhouseCoopers (PwC) on the evolution of the SAQ business model entitled "Évolution du modèle d'affaires de la SAQ", submitted to the Government on 12 September 2018, and, if necessary, make the appropriate recommendations to modernize the SAQ business model and promote Québec product sales;

THAT, within the framework of this mandate, the Committee hold special consultations and public hearings and that, for this purpose, it hear the authors of the said report, the Société des alcools du Québec, the Association des marchands dépanneurs et épiciers du Québec, Mr. Frédéric Laurin, Professor at UQTR's Finance and Economy Department, and any individuals or organizations it deems necessary to convene;

THAT the organization of the mandate be entrusted to the members of the Committee;

THAT the Committee report to the Assembly not later than 1 November 2019, unless the Committee decides otherwise;

THAT, lastly, this motion become an order of the Assembly.

By leave of the Assembly to set aside Standing Order 185, Mr. Leitão (Robert-Baldwin), together with Mr. Marissal (Rosemont), Mr. Ouellet (René-Lévesque), Mr. Ouellette (Chomedey) and Mrs. Fournier (Marie-Victorin), moved:

WHEREAS, following the unanimous passing of Bill 150 on 12 June 2018, Québec collects the Québec sales tax from suppliers of services purchased online outside Québec since 1 January 2019;

THAT it call on the Government of Canada to put an end to the unfair tax treatment relating to e-commerce by making it mandatory for service suppliers to collect the federal sales tax (GST) on services purchased online outside the country.

The question was put on this motion, and a recorded division was thereupon demanded.

The debate continued.

The debate being concluded, the report was concurred in.

#### Passage in Principle

Mrs. LeBel, Minister of Justice, moved that Bill 20, An Act to implement certain recommendations of the 20 August 2018 report of the committee on the remuneration of judges and justices of the peace for 2016–2019, do now pass in principle.

A debate arose thereon.

The debate was adjourned in the name of Mr. Tanguay (LaFontaine).
