The Assembly proceeded to Oral Question Period.

At the request of the President, Mr. Legault, Premier, withdrew certain words deemed unparliamentary.

By leave of the Assembly to set aside Standing Order 53, Mrs. Blais, Minister Responsible for Seniors and Informal Caregivers, tabled the following:

A copy of a letter, dated 25 March 2019, addressed to the president and executive directors and executive directors of public health and social services institutions by Mr. Yvan Gendron, Deputy Minister at the Ministère de la Santé et des Services sociaux, about extreme heat episodes in residential and long-term care centres (CHSLD).

Deferred Divisions

The Assembly took the divisions, which had been deferred at the sitting of 15 May 2019, on the motion moved by Mrs. Dorion (Taschereau) and on the amendment motion moved by Mr. Nadeau-Dubois (Gouin) during Business Standing in the Name of Members in Opposition.

First, the question was put on the amendment motion moved by Mr. Nadeau-Dubois (Gouin).

This motion reads as follows:

THAT the motion moved by the Member for Taschereau be amended as follows:

By adding the following paragraph after paragraph 3: "4) it will demand a block transfer of all federal infrastructure budgets."

The amendment motion was negatived on the following vote:

The question was then put on the motion moved by Mrs. Dorion (Taschereau).

This motion reads as follows:

THAT the National Assembly ask the Québec Government to confirm that

- 1) the structuring public transit network project for Québec City will be carried out as planned, without dividing it into parts or carrying it out in phases;
- 2) the project will be funded with federal funds, according to the agreed plan, as soon as possible; and
- 3) it will demand Québec's full and rightful share of funding for building green infrastructure throughout Québec.

The motion was negatived on the following vote:

Motions Without Notice

THAT the National Assembly raise the Patriote flag on the occasion of National Patriots' Day;

By leave of the Assembly to set aside Standing Order 185, Mr. Dubé, Minister Responsible for Government Administration and Chair of the Conseil du trésor, together with Mr. Barrette (La Pinière), Mrs. Dorion (Taschereau), Mr. Bérubé, Leader of the Third Opposition Group, and Mrs. Fournier (Marie-Victorin), moved:

THAT the National Assembly reaffirm its support to Québec City's structuring public transit network;

THAT it reiterate its commitment to having the project carried out;

THAT it ask the Government to fund the project with federal funds as soon as possible;

THAT it ask the Government to use Québec's full and rightful share of funding for building green infrastructure throughout Québec.

The question was put on this motion, and a recorded division was thereupon demanded.

The motion was carried on the following vote:

Yeas: 114 Nays: 0 Abstentions: 0

Mr. Barrette (La Pinière), together with Mrs. Dorion (Taschereau) and Mr. Ouellette (Chomedey), moved a motion on Québec's proposed list of projects to be funded within the green infrastructure component of the Integrated Bilateral Agreement Canada-Québec; this motion could not be debated for want of unanimous consent.

Mr. Zanetti (Jean-Lesage), together with Mrs. David (Marguerite-Bourgeoys), Mr. Ouellette (Chomedey) and Mrs. Fournier (Marie-Victorin), moved a motion on Bill 21, An Act respecting the laicity of the State; this motion could not be debated for want of unanimous consent.

Notices of Proceedings in Committees

Mr. Schneeberger, Deputy Government House Leader, convened the following committees:

— the Committee on Institutions, to continue its public hearings within the framework of special consultations on Bill 21, An Act respecting the laicity of the State; and then, continue its clause-by-clause consideration of Bill 6, An Act to transfer responsibility for the registry of lobbyists to the Lobbyists Commissioner and to implement the Charbonneau Commission recommendation on the prescription period for bringing penal proceedings;

- the Committee on Health and Social Services, to continue its clause-byclause consideration of Bill 2, An Act to tighten the regulation of cannabis;
- the Committee on Public Finance, to continue its clause-by-clause consideration of Bill 13, An Act to amend the Taxation Act, the Act respecting the Québec sales tax and other legislative provisions;
- the Committee on Citizen Relations, to continue its clause-by-clause consideration of Bill 9, An Act to increase Québec's socio-economic prosperity and adequately meet labour market needs through successful immigrant integration;
- the Committee on Culture and Education, to hold public hearings within the framework of special consultations on Bill 5, An Act to amend the Education Act and other provisions regarding preschool education services for students 4 years of age.

Mrs. Soucy, Second Vice-President, gave the following notices:

- the Committee on Labour and the Economy shall hold a deliberative meeting to discuss the possibility of examining a petition;
- the Committee on Institutions shall hold a deliberative meeting to prepare the hearing of the Chief Electoral Officer of Québec; then, hold a public meeting to hear the Chief Electoral Officer of Québec; and finally, hold a deliberative meeting to discuss the observations, conclusions and recommendations, if any, following this hearing.

Government Bills

Passage in Principle

The Assembly resumed the debate, which had been adjourned on 15 May 2019, on the motion moved by Mrs. Laforest, Minister of Municipal Affairs and Housing, that Bill 16, An Act mainly to regulate building inspections and divided co-ownership, to replace the name and improve the rules of operation of the Régie du logement and to amend the Act respecting the Société d'habitation du Québec and various legislative provisions concerning municipal affairs, do now pass in principle.

The debate being concluded, the question was put on the motion, and a recorded division was thereupon demanded.

The motion was carried on the following vote:

Yeas: 96 Nays: 0 Abstentions: 0

Bill 16 was accordingly passed in principle.

Mr. Schneeberger, Deputy Government House Leader, moved that Bill 16 be referred to the Committee on Planning and the Public Domain for clause-by-clause consideration.

Mr. Bonnardel, Minister of Transport, moved that Bill 17, An Act respecting remunerated passenger transportation by automobile, do now pass in principle.
