#### **Motions Without Notice**

Pursuant to Standing Order 26.1, Mr. Jolin-Barrette, Government House Leader, moved:

THAT, to conclude consideration of Bill 34, An Act to simplify the process for establishing electricity distribution rates, the Assembly appoint the hours of meeting as follows:

THAT the Assembly be permitted to sit every day, beginning at 9.00 o'clock a.m., until it has concluded consideration of the matter for which it was summoned or until it decides to adjourn its proceedings.

Pursuant to Standing Order 26.1, Mr. Jolin-Barrette, Government House Leader, moved:

THAT, in order to conclude consideration of Bill 34, An Act to simplify the process for establishing electricity distribution rates, the Assembly establish the exceptional legislative procedure as provided for in Standing Orders 182 to 184.2 and 257.1 to 257.10;

THAT the President be permitted to suspend the proceedings at any time during the sitting at the request of a Minister or Deputy Government House Leader.

At 10.03 o'clock a.m., the President suspended the proceedings to allow the Members to examine the motions moved by Mr. Jolin-Barrette, Government House Leader.

The proceedings resumed at 10.36 o'clock a.m.

The President informed the Assembly that the motion moved by Mr. Jolin-Barrette, Government House Leader, was in order.

#### **Limited Debate**

The President informed the Assembly of the allocation of speaking time for the proceedings with respect to this limited debate on the reasons why the Assembly was summoned for extraordinary sittings and on both motions moved by the Government House Leader, namely the motion to appoint the times during which the Assembly shall meet and the motion to introduce an exceptional legislative procedure: 58 minutes 30 seconds to the parliamentary group forming the Government; 34 minutes 51 seconds to the parliamentary group forming the Official Opposition; 12 minutes 27 seconds to the Second Opposition Group; 11 minutes 12 seconds to the Third Opposition Group; and 1 minute 30 seconds to each independent Member. However, if only one independent Member takes part in the debate, that Member's speaking time is 2 minutes. Within this framework, any time not used by the independent Members or by a parliamentary group shall be redistributed among the parliamentary groups in the proportions established above. Lastly, individual addresses shall not be limited.

A debate arose thereon.

#### **Government Bills**

Committee of the Whole

Pursuant to the order just adopted, the Assembly resolved itself into a Committee of the Whole for clause-by-clause consideration of Bill 34, An Act to simplify the process for establishing electricity distribution rates.

The Committee of the Whole undertook clause-by-clause consideration of Bill 34.

With the permission of Mr. Picard, First Vice-President, Chair of the Committee of the Whole, Mrs. Ghazal (Mercier) tabled the following:

A bundle of amendments to Bill 34, An Act to simplify the process for establishing electricity distribution rates.

(Sessional Paper No. 1282-20191206)

Since the time allotted to the Committee of the Whole had elapsed, Bill 34 was thereupon reported.

Report Stage

The Assembly took into consideration the report from the Committee of the Whole on its clause-by-clause consideration of Bill 34, An Act to simplify the process for establishing electricity distribution rates, together with the amendments transmitted by Mr. Julien, Minister of Energy and Natural Resources, Mr. Polo (Laval-des-Rapides), Mrs. Ghazal (Mercier) and Mr. Gaudreault (Jonquière).

The amendments were declared in order, except the amendment proposed by Mr. Polo (Laval-des-Rapides) to section 1, because it alters the principle of the bill, and except the amendment proposed by Mrs. Ghazal (Mercier) to section 14.1, because it introduces a new principle into the bill.

Mr. Picard, First Vice-President, informed the Assembly of the allocation of speaking time for the proceedings with respect to this debate: 29 minutes 15 seconds to the parliamentary group forming the Government; 17 minutes 26 seconds to the parliamentary group forming the Official Opposition; 6 minutes 13 seconds to the Second Opposition Group; 5 minutes 36 seconds to the Third Opposition Group; and 45 seconds to each independent Member. However, if only one independent Member takes part in the debate, that Member's speaking time is 1 minute. Within this framework, any time not used by the independent Members or by a parliamentary group shall be redistributed among the parliamentary groups in the proportions established above. Lastly, individual addresses shall not be limited.

A debate arose thereon.

Mr. Picard, First Vice-President, following a speech by Mr. Tanguay, Official Opposition House Leader, indicated that an alleged breach of privilege must be raised immediately after the breach occurs or by written notice transmitted to the President not later than one hour before Routine Proceedings. Since the facts raised by the Official Opposition House Leader had not just occurred, he would have to notify the President in writing in accordance with the second paragraph of Standing Order 69.

The debate continued.

The debate being concluded, Mr. Picard, First Vice-President, put the question on the amendments.

The questions were put severally on the amendments proposed by Mr. Julien, Minister of Energy and Natural Resources. The amendments to sections 19 and 20 were carried. The amendments to sections 2, 5, 14, 17, and 21 as well as the amendment introducing section 20.1 were carried on division.

The amendments proposed by Mr. Polo (Laval-des-Rapides), on questions put severally thereon, were negatived.

The amendments proposed by Mrs. Ghazal (Mercier), on questions put thereon, were negatived.

The amendments proposed by Mr. Gaudreault (Jonquière), on questions put severally thereon, were negatived.

Amended sections 2, 5, 14, 17 and 19 were carried. Amended sections 20 and 21 were carried on division.

The sections of the bill that the Committee of the Whole had not disposed of, on questions put severally thereon, were carried on division.

The title of the bill, the motion to adjust the references contained in the bill, and the motion to renumber the bill, on questions put thereon, were carried.

The question was put on the report, as amended, and a recorded division was thereupon demanded.

The amended report was concurred in on the following vote:
