EXPLANATORY NOTES

This bill amends the Professional Code in order to provide for the implementation of the Entente entre le Québec et la France en matière de reconnaissance mutuelle des qualifications professionnelles.

To that end, the bill authorizes the issue of a permit or a specialist's certificate to a person who meets the terms and conditions determined by regulation of the governing body of a professional order that are required to give effect to an agreement entered into by the order under an agreement for mutual recognition of professional competence entered into between the Government and another government.

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE ENTENTE ENTRE LE QUÉBEC ET LA FRANCE EN MATIÈRE DE RECONNAISSANCE MUTUELLE DES QUALIFICATIONS PROFESSIONNELLES

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Section 42 of the Professional Code (R.S.Q., chapter C-26) is amended by inserting the following paragraph after paragraph 2:

"(2.1) have the professional competence required in a regulation made under paragraph c.2 of section 93 and meet the terms and conditions determined in the regulation;".

2. Section 93 of the Code, amended by section 61 of chapter 11 of the statutes of 2008, is again amended by inserting the following paragraph after paragraph c.1:

"(c.2) determine the terms and conditions applicable to the issue of a permit or a specialist's certificate that are required to give effect to an agreement entered into by the order under an agreement for mutual recognition of professional competence entered into between the Government and another government;".

3. This Act comes into force on (*insert the date of assent to this Act*).
