AN ACT TO REPEAL THE ACT TO ENSURE THE ENLARGEMENT OF PARC NATIONAL DU MONT-ORFORD, THE PRESERVATION OF THE BIODIVERSITY OF ADJACENT LANDS AND THE MAINTENANCE OF RECREATIONAL TOURISM ACTIVITIES

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1.** The Act to ensure the enlargement of Parc national du Mont-Orford, the preservation of the biodiversity of adjacent lands and the maintenance of recreational tourism activities (2006, chapter 14) is repealed.
