EXPLANATORY NOTES

This bill amends the Labour Code so that a minimum percentage of services are maintained at all times where the Government makes an order directing a public transit authority constituted by the Act respecting public transit authorities and a certified association to maintain essential services in the event of a strike.

AN ACT TO AMEND THE LABOUR CODE

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Section 111.0.18 of the Labour Code (R.S.Q., chapter C-27) is amended by replacing “In a public service” in the first line of the first paragraph by “Subject to section 111.0.18.1, in a public service”.

2. The Code is amended by inserting the following section after section 111.0.18:

“111.0.18.1. During a strike of the employees of a public transit authority constituted by the Act respecting public transit authorities (chapter S-30.01), a minimum of 80% of services must be maintained at all times.”

3. This Act comes into force on (*insert the date of assent to this Act*).
