On 6 October 2020, the governments of Canada and Québec announced they had entered into an agreement for nearly \$3.7 billion over 10 years for housing. If we look at the terms of that agreement, it “provides for total federal funding of \$1.84 billion and involves a financial commitment from Québec equivalent to the federal commitment for the three components covered by the Agreement:

- \$272.25 M for the “Quebec Priorities” component;
- \$1.12 B for the “Canada Community Housing Initiative” component; and
- \$454.3 M for the “Canada Housing Benefit” component.”

We understand that the shared objective of the agreement is to reduce the number of households in housing need. However, we would like to clarify the following points:

- As concerns the \$272.25 M, how does the government of Québec intend to break down that sum according to “Quebec’s priorities”, and how many housing units in addition to those already announced does it intend to build?
- Given that the Canadian government’s National Housing Strategy was developed on the basis of a Gender-Based Analysis Plus (GBA+), that it was included in the Federal Plan for Gender Equality and that it therefore allowed 25% of the sums earmarked for the Strategy to be directed to projects targeting the special needs of women, girls and their families, will these targets remain among the priorities established by Québec? If so, how will the sums be allocated, and will you conduct a Gender-Based Analysis

Plus from an intersectional perspective (GBA+) in the programs, policies and actions funded by these sums for social housing?
