

AGREEMENT FOR ADDITIONAL FUNDING ON THE
PROVISION OF POLICING SERVICES

AMONG

The KATIVIK REGIONAL GOVERNMENT
represented by its Chairperson and by its Secretary
(hereinafter referred to as the "KRG")

AND

THE GOUVERNEMENT DU QUÉBEC
represented by the ministre de la Sécurité publique, and
the ministre responsable des Affaires intergouvernementales canadiennes,
des Affaires autochtones, de la Francophonie canadienne,
de la Réforme des institutions démocratiques et de l'Accès à l'information
(hereinafter referred to as "Quebec")

WHEREAS the KRG, a legal person established in the public interest pursuant to the *Act respecting Northern Villages and the Kativik Regional Government* (R.S.Q., c. V-6.1) (hereinafter referred to as the "Kativik Act"), Canada and Quebec agree on the importance of the delivery of professional policing services in the territory of the Kativik Region as defined in section 2 (v) of the Kativik Act, in accordance with the *James Bay and Northern Québec Agreement*, applicable agreements, statutes and regulations, and the respective jurisdictions of each of the Parties;

WHEREAS the Parties recognize that the members of the Kativik Regional Police Force (KRPF) must possess the basic police patrolling skills as well as investigation and management skills to deliver effective policing services and ensure security in the Kativik Region;

WHEREAS the Parties recognize that effective policing services require mutual assistance and operational co-operation between the various police forces that operate in Quebec, in accordance with their respective mandates and applicable statutes;

WHEREAS the KRG is a municipality within the meaning of the *Police Act* (R.S.Q., c. P-13.1) and the KRPF is governed in particular by this statute;

WHEREAS the KRG, Canada and Québec have entered into a tripartite agreement for the provision of policing services for the 2008-2009 fiscal year (hereinafter referred to as the tripartite agreement).

THE PARTIES AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

1. The preamble is an integral part of this Agreement.
2. The present Agreement shall not modify in anyway the tripartite agreement.
3. All provisions of the tripartite agreement shall apply to the present Agreement.
4. Quebec agrees to provide a complementary contribution of 1 723 077 \$ for the 2008-2009 fiscal year to the funding provided for in the tripartite agreement for the provision of policing services.

5. Quebec shall pay the KRG the complementary contribution provided for under section 4 of this Agreement in four equal instalments on June 1, 2008, August 1, 2008, November 1, 2008 and February 1, 2009.
6. Quebec's contribution of funds for the provision of policing services is subject to the appropriation of resources by the Quebec National Assembly.
7. Notwithstanding the date it is signed, this Agreement covers the period from April 1, 2008, to March 31, 2009.
8. Quebec undertakes to initiate the negotiation of the renewal of the tripartite agreement ending on March 31, 2009 with Canada and the KRG no later than May 1 2008, with the objective to conclude a five year agreement no later than March 31, 2009.
