**An Act respecting the transfer of certain
municipal employees exercising
functions related to food inspection**

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EXPLANATORY NOTES

The purpose of this bill is to enable certain municipal employees exercising functions related to food inspection to be integrated into the public service.

The bill also provides for the transfer of the food inspection records that belong to the municipal administrations concerned to the Ministère de l'Agriculture, des Pêcheries et de l'Alimentation.

AN ACT RESPECTING THE TRANSFER OF CERTAIN MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES EXERCISING FUNCTIONS RELATED TO FOOD INSPECTION

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. A person who, on 1 May 2001, was a member of the personnel of the Communauté urbaine de Montréal or a member of the personnel of the cities of Québec, Sherbrooke or Trois-Rivières and who, on that date, held a regular position and exercised functions considered necessary to food inspection becomes, not later than 1 January 2003, an employee of the Ministère de l'Agriculture, des Pêcheries et de l'Alimentation insofar as the person is covered by a decision of the Conseil du trésor made before that latter date, on the conditions determined therein, if the person is a permanent employee of one of those cities or of the city of Montréal on the day preceding the day of the person's transfer. A person so transferred is deemed to have been appointed in accordance with the Public Service Act (R.S.Q., chapter F-3.1.1).

The Conseil du trésor may determine the classification, remuneration and any other condition of employment that will apply to the person so transferred.

2. The records, documents and archives concerning food inspection and belonging to the cities of Québec, Sherbrooke or Trois-Rivières become, from 1 January 2002, records of the Ministère de l'Agriculture, des Pêcheries et de l'Alimentation. The records, documents and archives concerning food inspection and belonging to the city of Montréal become, from 1 January 2003, records of the Ministère de l'Agriculture, des Pêcheries et de l'Alimentation.
