EXPLANATORY NOTES

This bill entitles all employees to be absent from work for a minimum of four consecutive hours, without reduction in wages, to receive each dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, until the public health emergency declared by the Government on 13 March 2020 is lifted.

AN ACT TO ENTITLE EMPLOYEES TO A “VACCINE BREAK” TO RECEIVE A COVID-19 VACCINATION

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Any employee may be absent from work for a minimum of four consecutive hours, without reduction of wages, to receive each dose of the COVID-19 vaccine.

The employee must advise the employer as soon as possible of a period of absence from work.

2. This Act comes into force on (*insert the date of assent to this Act*) and ceases to have effect when the public health emergency declared by the Government on 13 March 2020 is lifted.
