Bill 896

An Act to amend the Election Act to encourage parity between women and men as candidates of political parties in a general election

Introduction

Introduced by Mr. Marc Tanguay Member for LaFontaine

EXPLANATORY NOTES

This bill amends the Election Act in order to encourage parity between women and men as candidates of political parties in a general election.

To do so, the bill provides that, in a general election, an authorized party must ensure that at least 40% of its recognized candidates are women. If a party contravenes this rule, the annual allowance paid to that party is reduced by 25%.

AN ACT TO AMEND THE ELECTION ACT TO ENCOURAGE PARITY BETWEEN WOMEN AND MEN AS CANDIDATES OF POLITICAL PARTIES IN A GENERAL ELECTION

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

ELECTION ACT

- **1.** The Election Act (chapter E-3.3) is amended by inserting the following section after section 82:
- "**82.0.1.** The amount of the allowance provided for in section 82 is reduced by 25% for an authorized party which contravenes section 259.0.1 by having fewer than 40% women as candidates in a general election."
- **2.** The Act is amended by inserting the following chapter after section 259:

"CHAPTER IV.0.1

"PARITY BETWEEN WOMEN AND MEN

"**259.0.1.** In a general election, an authorized party must ensure that at least 40% of its recognized candidates are women."

FINAL PROVISION
