Motions Without Notice

Ms. Montpetit (Maurice-Richard), together with Mr. Marissal (Rosemont), Mr. Ouellette (Chomedey), Mr. Roy (Bonaventure) and Mr. LeBel (Rimouski), moved a motion on establishing a crisis unit to fight against disruptions in services in the health network; this motion could not be debated for want of unanimous consent.

THAT it commit to passing an Act that regulates only demonstrations that seek to discourage a person from obtaining the COVID-19 vaccine or discourage a person from complying with the health measures issued by public health authorities in the context of the COVID-19 pandemic, and that take place in close proximity to specific places that are particularly sensitive;

THAT the National Assembly pledge not to restrict through legislation demonstrations by health care, education or childcare service network workers that do not constitute a danger to health and, in compliance with health measures, demand better remuneration or better working conditions, or better protection against the virus in the context of the pandemic.

Whereas, in September 2020, the Members carried a motion to promote the use and dissemination of the Quebec Sign Language (LSQ);

Whereas today marks the beginning of this interpretation for the Deaf and Sign Language communities;

THAT the National Assembly mark this historic development which corresponds with the International Day of Sign Languages proclaimed by the United Nations in 2017 and which is part of the International Week of the Deaf celebrated from September 20 to 26.

THAT, as soon as the Orders of the Day are called, the debate on the passage in principle of the bill be held;

THAT the debate on the passage in principle of the bill not exceed 45 minutes, allocated as follows: 13 minutes 7 seconds to the parliamentary group forming the Government, 17 minutes 30 seconds to the parliamentary group forming the Official Opposition, 6 minutes 15 seconds to the Members forming the Second Opposition Group, 4 minutes 23 seconds to the Members forming the Third Opposition Group and 3 minutes 45 seconds to the independent Members;

THAT, immediately thereafter, the bill be referred to a Committee of the Whole;

THAT, immediately thereafter, the Assembly resolve itself into a Committee of the Whole in order to undertake clause-by-clause consideration of the bill;

THAT clause-by-clause consideration of the bill be limited to three hours;

THAT the question then be put severally on any section the Committee may not have disposed of and all remaining elements of the bill;

THAT, immediately thereafter, the Committee of the Whole report to the Assembly and that proceedings be suspended;

THAT, not later than 5 minutes after the report of the Committee of the Whole is tabled, every Member may hand in to the Secretary General a copy of any amendment or amendments he or she may wish to move thereto;

THAT no subamendment may be moved;

THAT the Secretary General immediately forward a copy of those amendments to the House leader of each parliamentary group and to every independent Member;

THAT the President decide whether such amendments are in order and select them so as to prevent repetition and overlapping;

THAT, immediately thereafter, the question be put on the amendments, severally and without reading them beforehand, and then on the report of the Committee of the Whole;

THAT, immediately thereafter, the Assembly undertake the debate on the passage of the bill;

THAT this debate not exceed 45 minutes, allocated as follows: 13 minutes 7 seconds to the parliamentary group forming the Government, 17 minutes 30 seconds to the parliamentary group forming the Official Opposition, 6 minutes 15 seconds to the Members forming the Second Opposition Group, 4 minutes 23 seconds to the Members forming the Third Opposition Group and 3 minutes 45 seconds to the independent Members;

THAT all questions be put in accordance with the procedure for recorded divisions pursuant to the special order adopted on 14 September 2021;

THAT the Assembly or the Committee of the Whole, as the case may be, suspend its proceedings from 1:00 p.m. to 2:30 p.m.;

THAT the debates upon adjournment scheduled to be held on Thursdays be held instead beginning at 1:00 p.m. and that the suspension of proceedings be delayed accordingly;

THAT, at any time during the proceedings, a Minister or Deputy Government House Leader be permitted to move the suspension of the proceedings, the adjournment of the debate and the adjournment of the Assembly; that such a motion require no notice, cannot be amended or debated and that the question be immediately put on such a motion;
