Complaints of Breach of Privilege or Contempt and Personal Explanations

The President informed the Assembly that he had, within the prescribed time, received a request from Ms. Samson (Iberville) to be heard on an alleged breach of privilege.

In her notice, the Member for Iberville alleged that the Premier and the Minister of Public Security contravened section 56 of the *Police Act* by excluding her from the meetings preceding the appointment of the next Director General of the Sûreté du Québec, thereby undermining her parliamentary rights and privileges.

The notice further stated the Member for Iberville's intention to move a motion under Standing Orders 315 and following.

The President informed the Assembly that he would hear arguments at a later sitting.

Oral Questions and Answers

The Assembly proceeded to Oral Question Period.

Motions Without Notice

Mr. Zanetti (Jean-Lesage) moved a motion on establishing an independent committee of experts to study relations between the Service de police de la Ville de Québec and people from racialized communities; this motion could not be debated for want of unanimous consent.

Mr. Bérubé (Matane-Matapédia), together with Ms. Ghazal (Mercier), Mr. Roy (Bonaventure) and Mr. LeBel (Rimouski), moved a motion on the discontinuation of an intensive French language program at McGill University; this motion could not be debated for want of unanimous consent.

By leave of the Assembly to set aside Standing Order 185, Ms. Charest, Minister Responsible for the Status of Women, together with Ms. Melançon (Verdun), Ms. Massé (Sainte-Marie-Saint-Jacques), Ms. Perry Mélançon (Gaspé), Mr. Ouellette (Chomedey), Mr. Roy (Bonaventure) and Mr. LeBel (Rimouski), moved:

THAT the National Assembly mark the 12 Days of Action to End Violence Against Women, taking place from 25 November to 6 December:

THAT the Members of the National Assembly take this opportunity to reiterate their non-partisan unity in the fight against violence perpetuated toward girls and women;

THAT the Members applaud the colossal amount of work done by organizations that support victims of sexual violence and domestic violence and that they recall the importance of funding these organizations to meet their needs;

THAT they underline the courage of the women who have denounced the violence they have been the victim of, the women who are still living with their dark secret alone and, also, the loved ones who reach out to help these women;

THAT all Members of the National Assembly commit to denouncing this violence which cannot be tolerated in our society;

THAT the National Assembly deplore the fact that already in 2021, 18 women have been victims of feminicide;

THAT, lastly, the National Assembly observe a minute of silence in memory of all these women.

The question was put on this motion; in accordance with the motion carried by the Assembly on 14 September 2021, a vote was held in accordance with the procedure for recorded divisions.
