AN ACT TO RECOGNIZE THE MEMBERS' OATH TO THE PEOPLE OF QUÉBEC AS THE SOLE OATH REQUIRED FOR MEMBERS TO TAKE OFFICE

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The purpose of this Act is to recognize the Members' oath to the people of Québec as the sole oath required for Members to take office.

ACT RESPECTING THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY

2. Section 15 of the Act respecting the National Assembly (chapter A-23.1) is amended by adding the following at the end: "No other oath may be required of a Member to sit in the Assembly.

The oath is administered by the Secretary General."

FINAL PROVISION
