Mr. Arseneau (Îles-de-la-Madeleine), together with Ms. McGraw (Notre-Dame-de-Grâce), Ms. Zaga Mendez (Verdun) and Ms. Nichols (Vaudreuil), moved a motion on the project to relocate Cell 6 at the Stalex treatment centre in Blainville; this motion could not be debated for want of unanimous consent.

By leave of the Assembly to set aside Standing Order 185, Mr. Jacques (Mégantic), together with Ms. Maccarone (Westmount–Saint-Louis), Ms. Labrie (Sherbrooke), Mr. Arseneau (Îles-de-la-Madeleine) and Ms. Nichols (Vaudreuil), moved:

THAT it honour the work done by first responders, volunteers and local and national organizations to support the Lac-Mégantic community;

THAT, lastly, the National Assembly reiterate the importance of remembering the Lac-Mégantic rail tragedy and learning from it.
