

THAT the National Assembly underline the 3rd edition of the Festival du Livre de Paris, held from 12 to 14 April 2024, with Québec as guest of honour;

THAT it congratulate the 77 publishing houses and 42 writers from Québec who were invited by the Festival for their contribution to the promotion of Québec culture;

THAT, lastly, the National Assembly applaud the creativity of the Québec literary community, who has done a fine job of carving out Québec's place within La Francophonie.

THAT it condemn this interference;

THAT it support the Québec government's efforts to receive full and unconditional compensation for each intrusion on matters within Québec's areas of jurisdiction.
