

Oral Questions and Answers

The Assembly proceeded to Oral Question Period.

At the request of the President, Ms. Garceau (Robert-Baldwin) withdrew certain words deemed unparliamentary.

Motions Without Notice

By leave of the Assembly to set aside Standing Order 185, Mr. Derraji, Official Opposition House Leader, together with Mr. Roberge, Minister Responsible for Democratic Institutions, Mr. Zanetti (Jean-Lesage), Ms. Nichols (Vaudreuil) and Mr. Lefebvre (Arthabaska), moved:

THAT the National Assembly mark the 20th anniversary of the Institut du Nouveau Monde, an organization devoted to increasing citizen participation and building trust between citizens and their democratic institutions;

THAT it underline the immense privilege of living in a healthy democracy governed by the rule of law, where freedom of speech, association and the press are exercised, while democracies abroad are crumbling;

THAT it reiterate our responsibilities as elected officials to represent the entire population with dignity and to include them by giving them opportunities to participate in public debate and to inform our collective decisions between elections;

THAT it remind citizens of their responsibility to actively participate in democracy and to contribute to a healthy and respectful dialogue on the collective choices to be made.

By leave of the Assembly, a debate arose thereon.

The debate being concluded, the motion was carried.

Mr. Zanetti (Jean-Lesage), together with Mr. Bérubé (Matane-Matapédia), moved a motion on student financial assistance; this motion could not be debated for want of unanimous consent.

Mr. Arseneau (Îles-de-la-Madeleine), together with Mr. Fortin (Pontiac), Mr. Marissal (Rosemont) and Ms. Nichols (Vaudreuil), moved a motion on the Hôpital de Maria in the Gaspésie region; this motion could not be debated for want of unanimous consent.

By leave of the Assembly to set aside Standing Order 185, Mr. Skeete, Minister Responsible for the Fight Against Racism, together with Mr. Bérubé (Matane-Matapédia), moved:

THAT the National Assembly denounce the federal government's intention to broaden access to halal mortgages;

THAT it affirm that treating people differently according to their religious beliefs is discriminatory and contradicts the notion of laicity of the State.

The question was put on this motion, and an electronic division was thereupon demanded.

The motion was carried on the following vote:
