AN ACT RESPECTING THE DISSOLUTION OF THE AGENCE DE DÉVELOPPEMENT DE FERME-NEUVE

AS the Agence de développement de Ferme-Neuve was established in 2002 under the Act respecting the Agence de développement de Ferme-Neuve (2002, chapter 83);

AS the object of the Agence de développement de Ferme-Neuve is to carry out and finance the construction of municipal infrastructures and community equipment within the framework of a public-private partnership involving Municipalité de Ferme-Neuve;

AS the Agence de développement de Ferme-Neuve is no longer needed considering that the real estate development project was not as successful as anticipated;

AS it is expedient to dissolve the Agence de développement de Ferme-Neuve and to transfer its assets and liabilities to Municipalité de Ferme-Neuve;

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Agence de développement de Ferme-Neuve, established under the Act respecting the Agence de développement de Ferme-Neuve (2002, chapter 83), is dissolved and the agreement provided for in section 1 of the Act is terminated. The Agency's rights and obligations as well as its assets and liabilities are transferred to Municipalité de Ferme-Neuve.

2. Municipalité de Ferme-Neuve may, by a by-law requiring only the approval of the Minister of Municipal Affairs, Regions and Land Occupancy, order a loan not exceeding \$700,000 to discharge any liabilities transferred to the municipality under this Act.

3. The Act respecting the Agence de développement de Ferme-Neuve (2002, chapter 83) is repealed.

4. This Act comes into force on (*insert the date of assent to this Act*).
