EXPLANATORY NOTES

This bill amends the Act respecting the flag and emblems of Québec in order to recognize the “Plaid du Québec” tartan as the Québec tartan.

AN ACT TO AMEND THE ACT RESPECTING THE FLAG AND EMBLEMS OF QUÉBEC TO RECOGNIZE THE QUÉBEC TARTAN

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

ACT RESPECTING THE FLAG AND EMBLEMS OF QUÉBEC

1. The Act respecting the flag and emblems of Québec (chapter D-12.1) is amended by inserting the following section after section 5:

“5.1. The Québec tartan is registered under the name “Plaid du Québec” in the register established under the Scottish Register of Tartans Act 2008 (Scotland).

The tartan features the colours of Québec’s coat of arms, in particular blue, green, red and gold, as well as white, which refers to the scroll bearing the motto “*Je me souviens*”.”

FINAL PROVISION
